Below is a checklist to help you gain Nationally Recognised Qualifications in Outdoor Activities through Scouts NSW. The checklist is regularly updated according to feedback gained from people applying for the qualifications. The checklist helps you identify all the steps you need to complete to gain a qualification.

Please remember some basic rules for Outdoor Activities

1. Go with an experienced person,
2. Keep a logbook
3. Take lots of selfies!

Step 1. Collect relevant information

- Name
- Address
- Email
- Phone
- Date of birth
- Scout number
- USI number - <https://www.usi.gov.au>
- Working With Children Check – (WWCC)
<https://www.service.nsw.gov.au/transaction/apply-working-children-check>
- First aid certificate – current copy as all your qualifications are linked to this

Add the following if you have them

- Police clearance (if you already have one)
- Relevant qualifications

Step 2. Email Scouts NSW

- Send a polite email to Karen Huynh, Member Services Consultant at NSW Scouts to:
 - Provide her with information from Step 1
 - Request a 'Transcript of Academic Record' or 'VET transcript'. This is to confirm what information Scouts NSW has about you in regards to your qualifications.

Step 3. Documents that need to be up to date include:

- Logbook for each area of interest
- Pictures of you during the activities that you have logged
- Scouts eLearning modules - check again and again (Appendix A)

Step 4. Workbooks

- Relevant workbooks need to be completed (each activity has different levels and different requirements).
- Correct workbooks need to be completed - there are many, ask Karen Huynh or me if you are not sure which ones.
- Remember that in order to gain SIS qualifications you need 3 basic modules as well as your specific interest area.

Step 5. Complete enrolment form

- Complete and submit enrolment form to Karen Huynh

Step 6. Submit all documentation

- Send all evidence (logbook records and selfies) to Karen Huynh

Note: Level 2 and above - Third Party Declarations

- Ask experienced people who have been on activities with you and can verify that you are an experienced and competent person to complete the Third party Declaration Form (Appendix C) and add to your submission

Well done on submitting your application!!

The assessment of your application can take approx. 3 months.
